Enneagram Forums The Enneagram Forum is a web forum devoted to the 8-type personality map, created by Dennis and Jean Littman and Russell Cetina. While the Enneagram works can be used for introspection, the Forum is geared toward a student-teacher relationship with the map and the exercises designed for it. This Forum is maintained by the author, Russell Cetina. My wish is that people on this forum would be very helpful to each other as well as kind and respectful. If you have found this map helpful or interesting in any way please pass along the word to someone else. Why this forum? The actual reason I started the Enneagram Forums was that I saw people posting about this map and doing very interesting things with it, and I wanted to get involved. At first, it was just that: wanting to "get involved." The forums were intended to be a way to offer some support and help for those learning the Enneagram. Anyone could post about their experience with the map and ask questions. Over time, I began to notice some patterns in the posters' experience with it. For example, the people who had some experience with the map seemed to be able to articulate it more effectively than the people who didn't have such experience. I also noticed that certain people who had been doing some really interesting things with the map seemed to prefer to keep these things to themselves. In addition, I noticed that people who were in a teacher-student relationship tended to post more and request more help than people who were learning on their own. I began to wonder what this difference was, and what could be done about it. This is how the Forum idea developed. I realized that the people who were most interested in the map were not necessarily the people who needed the most help in working with it, and that I had a responsibility to design some kind of forum that would meet the needs of a wide variety of people. Also, I thought it might be interesting for someone who's never heard of the Enneagram to be able to get an introduction to
